Job Description:

AGGRASTAT®, an interventional cardiology drug, requires a high level of clinical expertise. As part of this role, you will be expected to absorb over 20 years of clinical data in acute coronary syndrome pharmacology for patients undergoing percutaneous coronary intervention in a very short period of time. Medicure offers a structured training program and will give you the tools needed to aid in your success.

You will be required to frequently travel to the United States to provide medical education, as well as represent Medicure at both regional and national cardiology conferences. All travel-related expenses will be absorbed by the Company. When you are not traveling, you will be based out of Medicure's head office located in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

Starting salary is \$55,000 to \$60,000. Salary reviews occur at 3, 6, and 12 months, with **attractive growth in compensation based on performance**. Other forms of compensation include an active benefits plan at time of hire, participation in Medicure's quarterly corporate bonus program, and stock option grants. A relocation package is included for those hired from out of province.

Responsibilities:

- Provides high quality, balanced and timely clinical, medical, and scientific information upon the request of external healthcare professionals as well as internal Medicure functional areas such as clinical development, manufacturing, quality assurance, regulatory affairs, and R&D.
- Represents Medicure at continuing educational events/programs, medical meetings and conferences.
- Maintain working and current knowledge of published medical literature, disease states and their treatments related to relevant Medicure products.

- Supports commercial teams with medical and scientific expertise.
- Identify Key Opinion Leaders (KOLs), and establish and maintain scientific relationships with KOLs.
- Develop and execute territory plans in alignment with regional and national plans of action (POAs).
- Collaborate across multiple functions and within a region(s) to maximize territory opportunities.
- Fulfills unsolicited requests, coordinates and delivers scientific, pharmacoeconomic, and disease awareness information as presentations or other forms of scientific exchange to health care professionals.
- Collects medical insights and intelligence gathered from scientific exchange with thought leaders and interprets and communicates relevant information in order to define, update, and support medical strategies.
